Payment for school camp is appreciated prior to your child's attendance at the activity.

PSSA activity, the \$10.00 charge for tryouts and participation will be invoiced via the school account. The school collects all participation fees and then facilitates the bulk payment to the PSSA Association for each event held.

Rosary Primary School has **BPay facilities** for account payments. This is the preferred method for paying all fees, and details are on the fee statement. All other means of payment such as direct debit, cheque, cash, eftpos and credit card are still available.

Direct debit: The amount for direct debit depends on the number of children in the family and the frequency of payment (ie monthly or fortnightly). Please see the front office for a break down of payments. If you currently have a direct debit active with the school you may need to make the necessary adjustment to reflect the new fee schedule. D/D forms are available from the office.
